"The Commonwealth Key and Personal Property Registry, 9 Queen Street, Melbourne, Telephone 301, register the property of citizens, e.g., a Bag, an Umbrellá, a Bunch of Keys, etc., and furnish a Metal Tag for attachment to the registered article. This requests the finder to return the article to the nearest Police Station and promises a reward of 5/- to the finder."

"In the event of such lost registered property being returned to any Police Station, the member of the Force is herewith instructed to communicate with the Registry and obtain the address of the Owner, to whom the lost article can now be restored. At the same time, name and address of the finder should also be furnished to the Registry, who will pay the finder the reward."
